



## REGULATIONS GOVERNING ACCESS AND ADMISSION TO MASTER'S DEGREES

**Title of the Master's degree:** Classical Archaeology (interuniversity)

### ADMISSIONS

**Number of places:** The number of places available is 25.

#### Access qualifications:

- Official university degrees in History, Archaeology and History of Art, and related fields.
- Official university degrees in Humanities, Philology, Social and Cultural Anthropology, Geography, and related fields.
- Holders of diplomas, technical architects and technical engineers in related fields.
- Official degrees from higher education institutions of the EHEA that enable students to move on to a master's programme in the country of issue.
- Degrees awarded by educational systems outside the EHEA and which have not been officially recognized provided that the university can determine:
  - that the educational level attained is equivalent to that of the corresponding official Spanish university qualifications; and
  - that the student is entitled to enter postgraduate programmes in the country of issue.

During the admissions period, students must accredit that they meet both requirements. To accredit that they hold a suitable access qualification, students must provide the relevant certificate, provisional certificate, European supplement to the qualification, etc. To determine the student's level of English, in addition to requesting certificates that accredit language knowledge, the Admissions Committee for the Master's degree may establish mechanisms such as interviews or level tests.

Students who access the Master's course by means of related qualifications:

- Degree in Humanities
- Degree in Classical Philology
- Degree in Social and Cultural Anthropology
- Degree in Geography
- Architects or Engineers

who have completed 18 credits of the bridging course subjects listed below:

In addition to holding one of the aforementioned qualifications, students may be required to study bridging courses depending on the previous training that they have accredited. For this reason the Admissions Committee will evaluate whether the student must complete bridging courses in other subjects not mentioned here.

To obtain these 18 bridging credits, students will be informed which subjects they need to take from those offered by the degree in History at the URV and the degree in Archaeology at the UAB:

#### URV

*Archaeology of Greece or History and Archaeology of Greece: 6 ECTS credits*

*Archaeology of Rome or History and Archaeology of Rome: 6 ECTS credits*

*Protohistory of the Mediterranean: 6 ECTS credits*

#### UAB

*Epigraphy and Numismatics: 6 ECTS credits*

*Tools for Classical Studies: 6 ECTS credits*



## PRE-REGISTRATION PROCESS

### School/faculty responsible for pre-registration

The Postgraduate and Doctoral School will pre-register those students with foreign degrees that have not been approved by the Spanish Ministry of Education, Sciences and Sports (MECD). All other students will be pre-registered by the Secretary's Office of the Academic Management Service at the Catalunya Campus.

### Deadline for applications

Applications must be made within the established period.

### Documents required

The documents must be presented before the end of the corresponding pre-registration period.

## SELECTION CRITERIA

Students will be selected on the basis of the following criteria:

1. Suitability of access qualification: up to 35 points, in the following order:
  - a. Graduates in the Humanities and the Social Sciences: up to 35 points,
  - b. Graduates in the fields of Engineering: up to 20 points,
  - c. Others: 0 points.
2. Evaluation of the academic transcript of the official university qualification that provides access to the Master's degree: up to 35 points.
3. Bridging courses related to the Master's degree (courses, seminars or other training activities, accrediting documents required): up to 20 points.
4. Knowledge of languages (English, French or German): up to 10 points.

Nevertheless, if there are not enough students to fill all the places available, the admissions body may admit all of the students without prioritizing them in terms of their merits.



### **SELECTION COMMITTEE**

The selection committee entrusted with appraising the applications will be made up of:

- The Director of the Master's degree in Classical Archaeology or delegated individual
- The Coordinator of the Master's degree in Classical Archaeology at the URV
- The Coordinator of the Master's degree in Classical Archaeology at the UAB
- The Coordinator of the Master's degree in Classical Archaeology at the ICAC
- The Head of the Admissions and Registration Unit of the URV's Catalunya Campus Secretariat for Academic Management

### **ADMISSION PROCEDURE**

The secretary's office of the faculty/school will announce the students who have been admitted and those who have not on the notice board and on the university's website.

Should places still be available once the registration process has finished, they will be offered to the students on the waiting list. Students will be notified individually of this process.

Within one month of the publication of the names of those admitted on the programme, applicants can lodge an appeal to the rector of the Universitat Rovira i Virgili.

### **REGISTRATION**

Students must register within the established periods.
