Access to electronic information

From the URV library you can access a great deal of electronic academic and scientific information of the highest quality.

ACCESS

- From within the URV, you have free access.
- From outside the URV you have to follow these [instructions](#) if you wish your computer to be recognised as a user with the right to access the information.

You may be asked for a login and a password: they are the same as the ones you use to access the other digital services of the URV (e.g. e-mail, moodle, etc.).

[i-Cerc@dor](#) is the portal that integrates all the electronic resources available at the URV Library and Documentation Service.

It enables you to search for **websites, library catalogues, bibliographic databases, electronic journals and books** (with access to the full text if we are subscribers) from a single search screen.
