1. Who is responsible for handling your data?

3. What do we use your data for?

To administer the dissemination of the URV's training programmes, activities and services and to manage communications with former, current and future students, the rest of the university community and businesses.

We may create a user profile based on the information that you give us so that we can send information on training programmes, activities and services that are in line with your interests and needs and so we can improve your user experience. Automated decisions may be taken on the basis of this profile.

4. How long will we keep your personal data for?

We will keep your data permanently unless you expressly ask us to remove it.

5. What is the legal basis that gives us the right to handle your data?

Your consent provides the legal basis that gives us the right to handle your data.

6. Who will you share my data with?

We will not share your data with third parties unless we are legally obliged to do so.

7. What are your rights?

Every individual has the right to be informed as to whether the URV is handling their personal data or not.

Every individual has the right to access their personal data, to rectify it and to ask for it to be removed if, among other reasons, the data are no longer required for the purpose for which they were originally collected.

In certain circumstances established in article 18 of the GDPR, individuals may request the restriction of the processing of their data. In these cases, we will only retain your data for the purposes of exercising or defending any claims.

Individuals may oppose the handling of their data for the purposes of marketing, including the creation of user profiles. The URV will cease to handle personal data if requested to do so by the interested party, unless there are overriding reasons not to do so or the URV needs to exercise or defend a legal claim.

Individuals also have the right to obtain their personal data in a commonly used electronic format and to transfer them to another controller.

8. How can I exercise my rights?

To exercise your rights, you must submit a written request in person or by post to C/Escorxador, s/n, 43003, Tarragona, or via the electronic registry at https://seuelectronica.urv.cat/registre.html

9. How can I make a claim?

If you think that your rights have been infringed, you have the right to submit a claim to the Autoritat Catalana de Protecció de Dades (Catalan Data Protection Authority). You can also submit a claim to the individual responsible for data protection at the URV.
