

18. Documentation required before expiry of deadline

Dear [Name of the candidate],

As we mentioned in the email confirming your pre-registration application, to enable the Coordinators / Academic Committee of the [Name of the Doctoral programme] to assess your pre-registration application, you must upload your basic access documentation to the <u>document manager</u> by [Last day of the pre-registration phase] at the latest.

Remember that at this stage your documentation does not need to fulfil all the <u>formal requirements</u> (attested copies, translations and legalizations, if necessary) in order for the Academic Committee to evaluate your application. However, you will be required to provide the relevant attested copies, translations and legalizations in order to complete the registration process.

If at the end of this period you have not delivered the original documents and copies of these in person or the originals of the certified copies by post or in person, the status of your application will be Excluded on technical grounds because we understand that you have withdrawn, in accordance with article 68.1 of Law 39/2015 of 1 October, on the common administrative procedure of public administrations.

If you are still interested in studying on this or any other Doctoral Programme, you will have to repeat the

pre-registration process and pay the corresponding fee, although the success of your application will depend on the availability of a place. You can consult the calendar here.
