Access qualifications

- Official university degrees (Bologna or pre-Bologna) in Chemistry, Biochemistry, Biology, Biotechnology, Pharmacy, Environmental Sciences, Food Science and Technology, Chemical Engineering and related subject areas.
- Degrees from higher education institutions of the EHEA whose qualification enables them to move on to a master's programme in the country of issue.
- Degrees awarded by educational systems outside the EHEA and which have not been officially recognized if the university can determine
 - that the educational level attained is equivalent to that of the official Spanish university qualifications; and
 - that the student is entitled to enter postgraduate programmes in the country of issue.

PRE-REGISTRATION PROCEDURE

Deadline for applications

Applications must be made within the established period.

Documents required

All documents must be presented before the corresponding pre-registration period is over.

SELECTION CRITERIA

The pre-registered applicants will be appraised and selected in accordance with the following criteria:

- Academic transcript
- Proficiency in English
- Qualifications other than the access qualification

For those applicants with degrees in unrelated subject areas:

- Provable practical knowledge of Analytical Chemistry (work experience in analytical laboratories or R+D)
- Recognized experience in chromatographic techniques and/or mass spectrometry

SELECTION COMMITTEE

The selection committee entrusted with appraising the applications will be made up of

- the coordinator from the Jaume I University (chair);
- the coordinators from the participating universities (URV, UdG); and
- the head of the secretary's office, who will act as the technical secretary.

ADMISSION PROCEDURE

The secretary's office of the faculty will announce the students who have been admitted and those who have not on the notice board and on the university's website. Students will also receive a personal response informing them of the result of their application and of the credits they have to take.

Should places still be available once the registration process has finished, they will be offered to the students on the waiting list. Students will be notified individually of this process.

Within one month of the publication of the names of those admitted on the programme, applicants can lodge an appeal to the rector of the Rovira i Virgili University.

REGISTRATION

Students must register within the established periods.
