



ACADEMIC REQUIREMENTS 2019-2020ⁱ

NEW STUDENTS

BACHELOR'S DEGREE

Registration grant

→ Students must show that they obtained a grade of at least **5** points in the general phase of the university access examinations (PAU).

Registration grant + other concepts

→ Students must show that they obtained a grade of at least **6.5** points in the general phase of the university access examinations (PAU).

MASTER'S DEGREE

Master's that **qualify** the holder for specific professional roles:

→ Students must have an average grade of **6.5** points for the academic transcript that qualifies them to study for the master's degree.

Masters that **do not qualify** the holder for specific professional roles:

→ Students must have an average grade of **7** points for the academic transcript that qualifies them to study for the master's degree.

→ The average grade of the transcript must be **multiplied by 1.17** for technical studies.

MASTER'S DEGREES

Master's that **qualify** the holder for specific professional roles:

→ Students must have an average grade of **6.5** points for the academic transcript of the first year of their master's degrees.

→ Students must pass **100%** of the credits for which they registered during the previous year.

Masters that **do not qualify** the holder for specific professional roles:

→ Students must have an average grade of **7** points for the academic transcript of the first year of their master's degrees.
