



General description/Objective

Awards for contracting and recruiting postdoctoral research staff to the Catalan Science and Technology System.

Total budget

€8,658,000.00. The 2018 Beatriu de Pinós programme 2020 is co-funded by the European Union through the COFUND programme of the Marie Skłodowska-Curie Actions to contract researchers by programmes of excellence and with the transnational movement within the Horizon 2020 Programme.

Grant amount

1. Cost of contract: €132,300/3 years (€44,100 €/year)
2. Complementary amount of €12,000

Funding terms

1. Cost of contract:

- **Remuneration** of research staff and Social Security contributions
- The beneficiary entity will cover the difference up to the total cost
- The beneficiary entity may increase the contributions of the research staff from its own funds

2. Complementary cost. Actions carried out by the research staff during the contract period:

- Eligible:
 - Scientific training activities and professional recruitment (management, organization, entrepreneurship, etc.)
 - Notable research activity (conferences, field work, short research visits abroad)
 - Research activity expenses (international meetings, academic literature subscriptions, stationery)
 - Expenses associated with intellectual property rights
- Not eligible: office and laboratory equipment, including computers and technical or IT services.

Duration of the grant

3 years. Contracting/employment period:

- 09/02/2021 (date of publication of the resolution of the award)
- 09/08/2021 (date specified in the call)
- 01/04/2022 (last day for the incorporation)

Awardee

1. Doctoral degree certificate between 01/01/2013 and 31/12/2018:

- Date doctoral degree awarded: date on which thesis was defended and approved.

- Circumstances under which the period in which the doctoral degree was awarded may be extended from 01/01/2011:
 - Absence due to maternity/paternity leave.
 - Responsibility for children under 6 years of age, for people with physical, psychiatric or sensory disability or for dependants over the age of 65.
 - Serious illness or an accident leading to sick leave equal to or greater than six months.
 - Refugee status in accordance with the terms of the 1951 Geneva Convention.
- 2. **Minimum 2 years postdoctoral experience outside Spain** on the start date, either in one or various institutions.
- 3. **Residence or work in Spain for less than 12 months in the last three years** prior to presenting the application. Refugee research staff: the mobility rule applies from the date on which the individual obtained official recognition of their status as a refugee, in accordance with the 1951 Geneva Conference

Documentation

1. General form:

- Details of the researcher responsible for reception and of the host institution
- Details of the candidate: personal details, academic details, postdoctoral visits, research projects, ethical aspects
- Additional documentation
- Other details/processes: declaration of special circumstances, personal data protection, acceptance of conditions and presentation protocol, maternity leaves, ID (passport, DNI or NIE) and the certification of the mobility experience.

Note: Individuals who sign their applications electronically must authenticate themselves through the electronic signature systems permitted by the electronic registry of the Catalan Government.

- Excellence 70%
 - Project and research activities..... 10%
 - Recipient group 20%
 - Candidate curriculum vitae 40%
- Impact:20%
 - Training and specialization activities 5%
 - Potential and strategic R+D impact 10%
 - Dissemination and communication activities..... 5%
- Planning and management of the proposal10%
 - Entity..... 5%
 - Supervision of the candidate 5%

2. Second phase: evaluation committees in the form of panels for each knowledge ambit

- External experts from different scientific ambits
- Review of the scores obtained in the first evaluation phase
- Awarding of final grade
