

Before your arrival

Application and acceptance procedure for visiting students

1. Students interested in coming to the university as visiting students must contact the relevant study coordinator who will:
 - ✓ Give them information regarding subjects and the ECTS.
 - ✓ Agree (together with the student) the subjects to be taken in the Academic Contract.
2. Students must submit their application:
 - a. For official degree studies to the dean or director of the faculty/school offering the subjects they wish to study.
 - b. For official Master's studies to the organ responsible for Master's admissions.
 - c. For Doctoral studies to the organ responsible for Doctoral admissions

Students must bring the following documentation:

- ✓ Application form (download document).
 - ✓ Academic Contract with the subjects the student wishes to study at the URV (download document).
 - ✓ Photocopy of passport or identity card.
 - ✓ Document detailing reasons for wanting to study at the URV.
 - ✓ Certificate of the university studies or other studies currently being taken.
 - ✓ Certificate confirming knowledge of the language, if applicable.
3. Once admitted, students must formally enrol at the secretary's office of the faculty/school to which they have applied and must bring the following documentation:
 - ✓ Original and copy of their European health card or proof that they have health insurance.
 - ✓ Original and copy their civil liability insurance (if they do not have this, they must take out the URV's cum laude voluntary insurance policy.)

It is very important that applying students are in permanent contact with the coordinators and that they ensure that the subjects they are interested in are available during the desired academic period. The student must be able to demonstrate sufficient knowledge of Spanish and/or Catalan. To find out which language a subject is given in, students should contact the coordinator of the faculty/school.
