

VALIDATIONS

The governing body of the Master's Degree may validate credits obtained from other courses or studies related to Business Law, up to a maximum of 60 ECTS credits.

The governing body of the Master will recognise all those credits obtained by Law students of the Rovira i Virgili University

PRE-REGISTRATION

The Faculty of Legal Sciences is responsible for managing the registration process.

RESEARCH SCHEDULE (DOCTORATE)

OBJETIVES

To provide comprehensive training in the system of business law and contracting, in addition to the practical tools and other skills required to succeed within the field of business and contracting research

ADRESSED TO

- Graduates in Law, Business Administration and Management and Work Sciences.

- Graduates or diplomates in Labour Relations, Business Science and Tourism.

Also:

- Graduates in areas related to those above.

- First or second cycle students who have not completed their first cycle studies but fulfil the following conditions:

o They have completed three years of study and have obtained at least 180 credits.

o The credits obtained must include all the core subjects in the present first cycle of official university studies.

o The first cycle subject area must be the courses in Law, Business Administration and Management and Work Sciences that allow access to the Master.

- Students who, without being in possession of the corresponding degree qualification, fulfil the following conditions:

o They have obtained at least 180 credits of their first-cycle courses.

o The credits obtained must include all the common course content of the degree course.

- Graduates of foreign education systems with an officially approved qualification. Foreign students whose qualifications do not require official approval who are able to prove that their level of education is equivalent to the corresponding Spanish degree qualification and that their qualification would allow access to Postgraduate studies in their own country. In all cases, the studies must have been undertaken for a minimum period of three years.

PROGRAMME

The master in Business Law has a maximum duration of 2 academic years (between 60 and 120 credits).

DOCTORAL THESIS

Students who have obtained a minimum of **60 credits** on the Official Master (to this effect validated credits are not counted) may defend the doctoral thesis and obtain the title of doctor.
