Please check this website: https://www.urv.cat/international/movilidad/en_coordinadores-movilidad.html</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - A2 level of Spanish is mandatory to attend the Bachelor's Degree of Psychology. - B1 level of Spanish is mandatory to attend the Bachelor's Degrees of Tourism and Hotel Management, Geography, Territorial Analysis and Sustainability, Architecture, Law, Social Work, Labour Relations, Chemical Engineering, Mechanical Engineering, Food Bioprocesses and Agricultural Engineering and the Master's Degrees in Urban Anthropology, Migrations and Social Intervention. - B2 level of Spanish is mandatory to attend the Bachelor's Degrees of Hispanic Language and Literature, Publicity and Public Relations, Journalism, Audio-visual Communication, Physiotherapy, Medicine, Human Nutrition and Dietetics and Nursing. - Official certificate of B2 level of Spanish is mandatory to attend the Master's Degree in Strategic Communication. - C1 official certificate of Spanish is mandatory to attend the Master's Degree in Teaching Languages: Spanish as a Foreign Language, Professional English-Spanish Translation and General Health Psychology. - B1 level of English is mandatory to attend subjects taught in English at the Faculty of Economics and Business. - B2 level of English is mandatory to attend all the Master's Degrees taught in English. - B2 official certificate of English is mandatory to attend the Bachelor's Degree of English. - C1 official certificate of English or a personal evaluation by the coordinator is mandatory to attend higher courses of the Bachelor's Degree of English and the Master's Degree in Professional English-Spanish Translation/ Teaching and Learning English as a Foreign and Second Language.
Academic Requirements	Students will have to choose, at least, 50% of the credits from the field of study under which they have been nominated and, therefore, agreed upon in the bilateral agreement.

	<p>Students can make their Bachelor's/Master's final thesis at the URV if they commit to defend it in person in July. These fields do not permit to develop the Bachelor's/Master's final thesis: Law, Labour Relations, Nursing, Medicine, Physiotherapy, Physiotherapy (EUSES), Physical Activity and Sport Science (EUSES), Nutrition and Dietetics, Audio-visual Communication, Journalism, Publicity and Public Relations, Geography, Territorial Analysis and Sustainability, Social Work, Tourism, English and Architecture.</p> <p>Training placements can be allocated upon request by sending a CV and a presentation letter, excepting in the field of Economics and Business and Communication studies.</p> <p>Smile Programme: work placements for incoming student, especially those who might wish to have a teaching experience in schools in English language, but also in French and Germany languages. Incoming students working as language assistants will obtain 6 ECTS credits after completing 40 hours of work placement.</p>
Covid Restrictions	No restrictions planned for incoming mobility. In case of new roots or waves, the admission of Nursing, Medicine, Human Nutrition and Dietetics and Physiotherapy incoming students and trainees can be paralyzed.
Registration	Exchange students must complete an URV online application and attach the required documents. At their arrival, students must attend a welcome session (virtual or in person), visit their academic coordinator and request the enrolment at the Campus secretariat.
