



Considering the Resolution of 13 October issued by the Rector on the measures to be applied in academia during the current pandemic, in response to the requirement by the PROCICAT of the same date;

Considering the extensions to the resolution of 13 October: resolutions of 30 October, 20 November, 25 November 2020 and 21 January 2020;

Considering Resolution SLT/67/2021, of 5 February, which extends and modifies all the measures on public health to contain the resurgence of the COVID-19 pandemic in Catalonia (DOGC no. 8335 of 6 February);

By virtue of the powers conferred on me by my position and considering the modifications made by the previous resolution in terms of the teaching first-year classes of university undergraduate degrees

I RESOLVE

1. At the discretion of those responsible for the faculty or school, and after listening to the arguments of the student delegates and the teaching staff, the first-year theory classes of bachelor's degrees can be taught in a blended or hybrid format. That is to say, the subjects can be taught online, as they have been up to now, also in the classroom or with a combination of the two systems. The technical means available in the classrooms must make it possible to make it easier for students who opt for non-attendance. Of course, at all times, the COVID-19 safety measures regarding the occupation and use of university classrooms and spaces must be respected.

Each faculty/school shall notify the students of the subjects affected by these changes through Moodle and any other information channels they believe to be appropriate. Likewise, if necessary, faculties/schools must notify students of the rooms that will be available to them (classrooms, CRAI, etc ...) so that they can follow subjects online when they have to be on campus for another online academic activity.

2. For all other years of undergraduate degrees and other degrees (master's and postgraduate), face-to-face activity in the classroom must be reserved exclusively for practicals and examinations that have been scheduled as classroom activities. Likewise, all other activities that have been defined as essential, including research, will continue to be carried out on site.

3. The opening of the CRAI and all its services will continue to depend on the resolutions issued as part of the Department of Health's Plan for the Progressively Resumption of Activity (Resolution SLT/1/2021).



4. All other on-site teaching and administrative activity will gradually be resumed in accordance with the instructions received from the health authorities.
5. This resolution enters into force on 8 February 2021 and will remain in force as long as the current measures issued by the health authorities are valid for university education.
