



Considering the Resolution of 13 October 2020 issued by the Rector on the measures to be applied in academia during the current pandemic, in response to the requirement by the PROCICAT of the same date;

Considering the extensions to the resolution of 13 October: resolutions of 30 October, 20 November, 25 November 2020, 21 January 2021 and 8 February 2021;

Considering the Resolution SLT/612/2021, of 5 March, which extends and modifies all the measures on public health to contain the resurgence of the COVID-19 pandemic in Catalonia (DOGC no. 8358 of 6 March);

By virtue of the powers conferred on me by my position and considering the modifications made by the Resolution SLT/612/2021 in terms of university teaching,

## **I RESOLVE**

1. After consulting with student delegates and the teaching staff, the management of faculties and schools can decide to teach bachelor's and master's courses in the blended or hybrid format. That is to say, they can teach the subjects online, face-to-face or with a combination of the two teaching formats.

3. Practicals and assessment activities can still be done on campus. For theoretical activities done on campus the increase in simultaneous attendance is restricted to a maximum of 30% of the student body of each faculty/school. That is to say, theoretical classes can be taught to classes that fill only 30% of the capacity of the classroom (considering the interpersonal distance 1.5 m).

The technology with which the classrooms are equipped must allow students to be able to opt not to attend in person. And, of course, all COVID-19 safety measures concerning the occupation and use of classrooms and university spaces must be respected.

Faculties/schools must notify students of the subjects affected by these changes through Moodle, and any other information channels deemed appropriate. Likewise, if necessary, faculties/schools must notify students of the rooms available to them (classrooms, CRAI, etc.) to follow subjects online when they have to be on campus for another face-to-face academic activity.

2. Likewise, all other activities defined as essential, such as research, are still regarded as on-site activities.



3. The opening of the library (CRAI) and all its services will depend on the resolutions issued as part of the Department of Health's Plan for the Progressive Opening Up of Activities, Resolution SLT/1/2021.

4. If necessary, the general manager shall determine what organisational changes are required in the administrative and service staff to guarantee the implementation of this resolution.

5. This resolution comes into force as from 8 March 2021 and will remain in force as long as the measures taken by the health authorities for university education are maintained.
