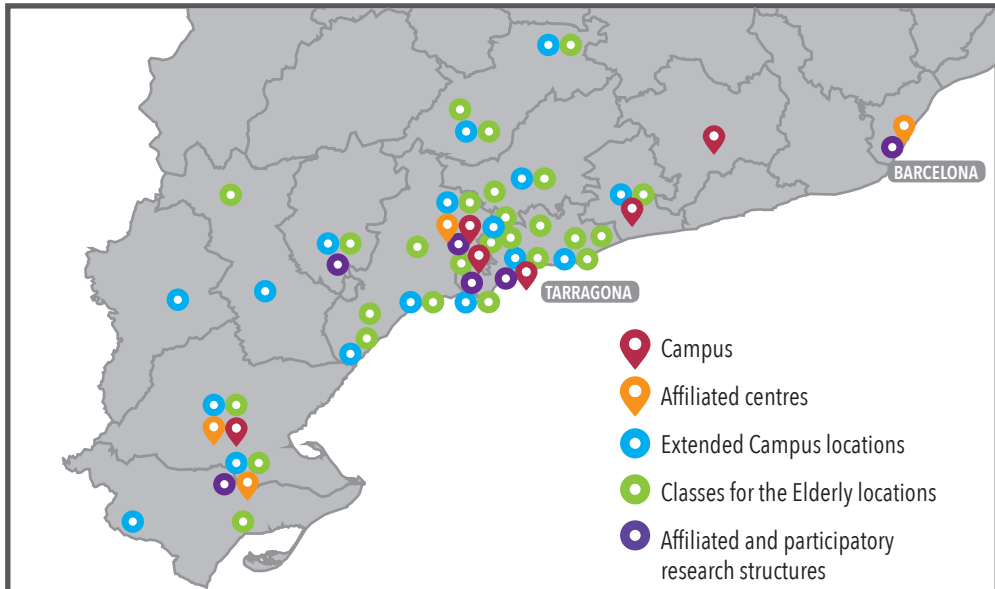

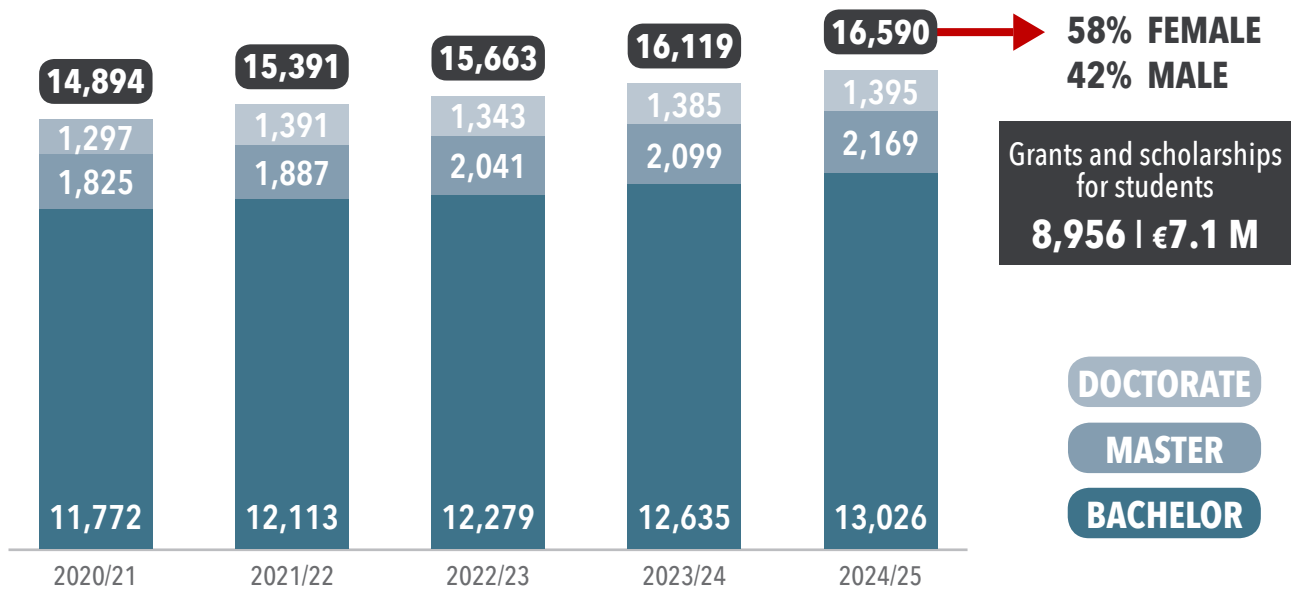

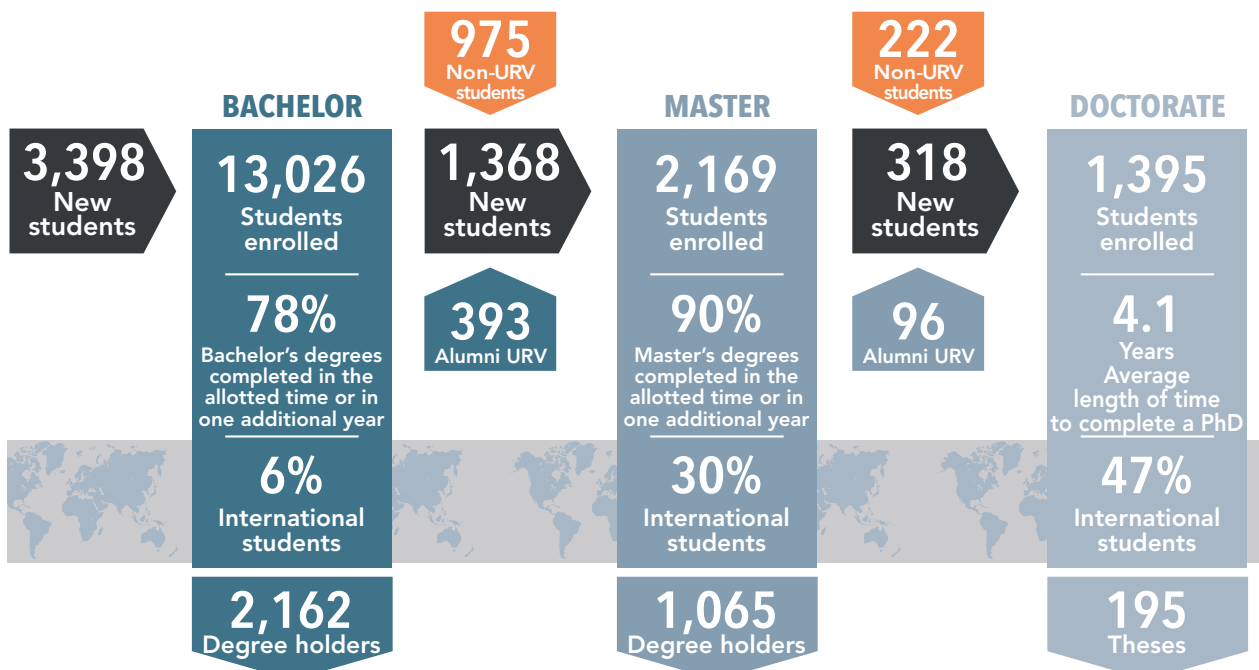

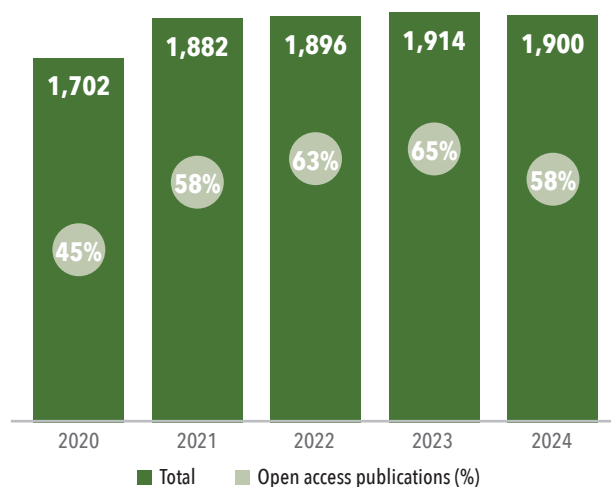
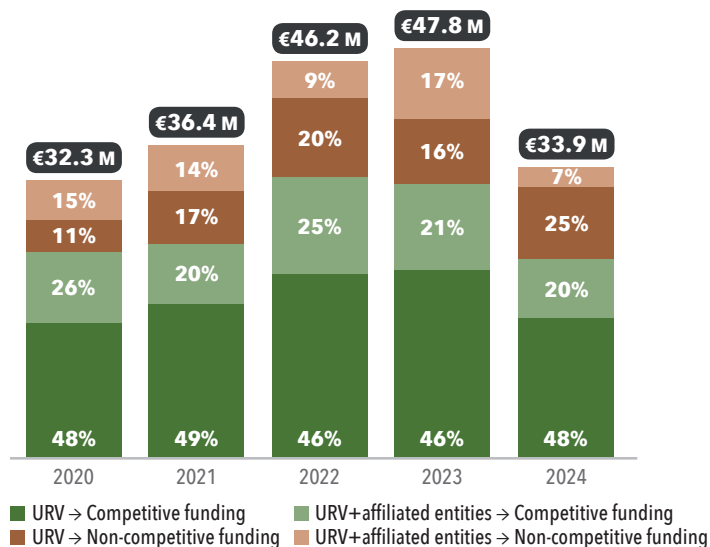
OVERALL VIEW. ACADEMIC YEAR 2024/25



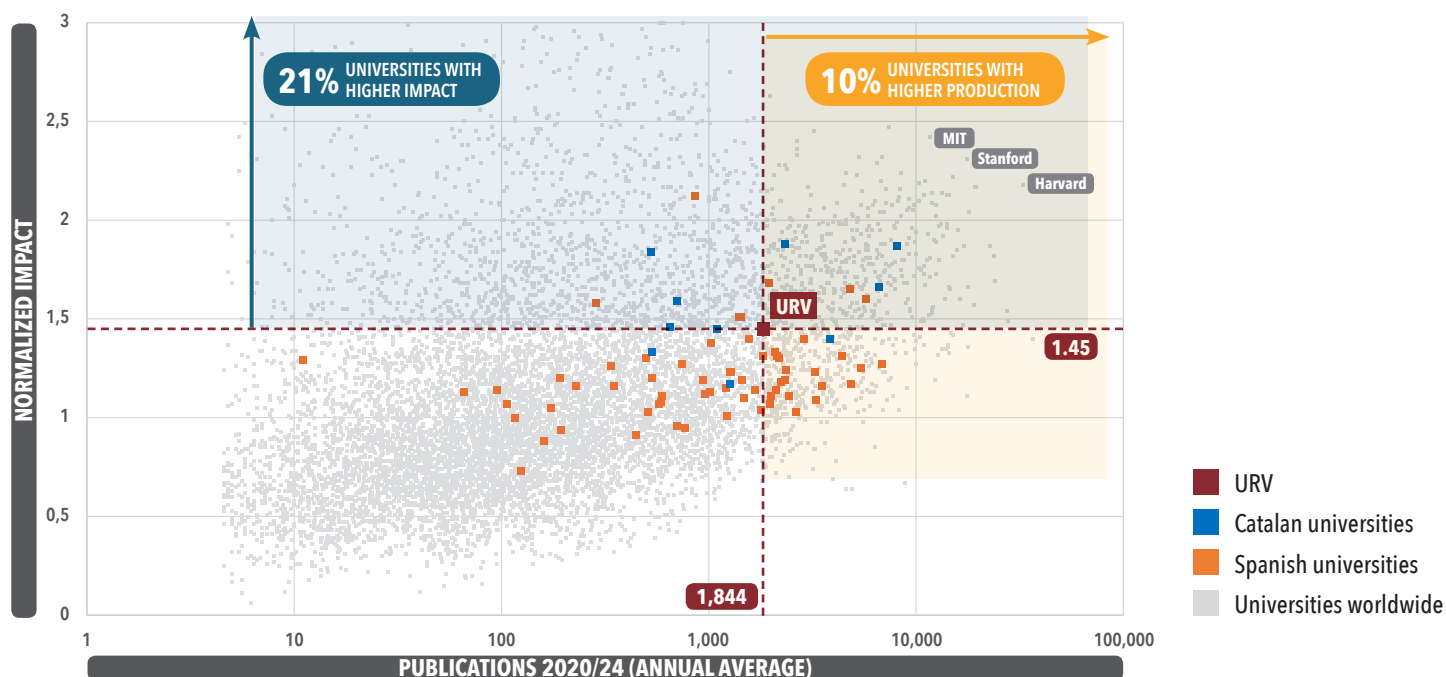

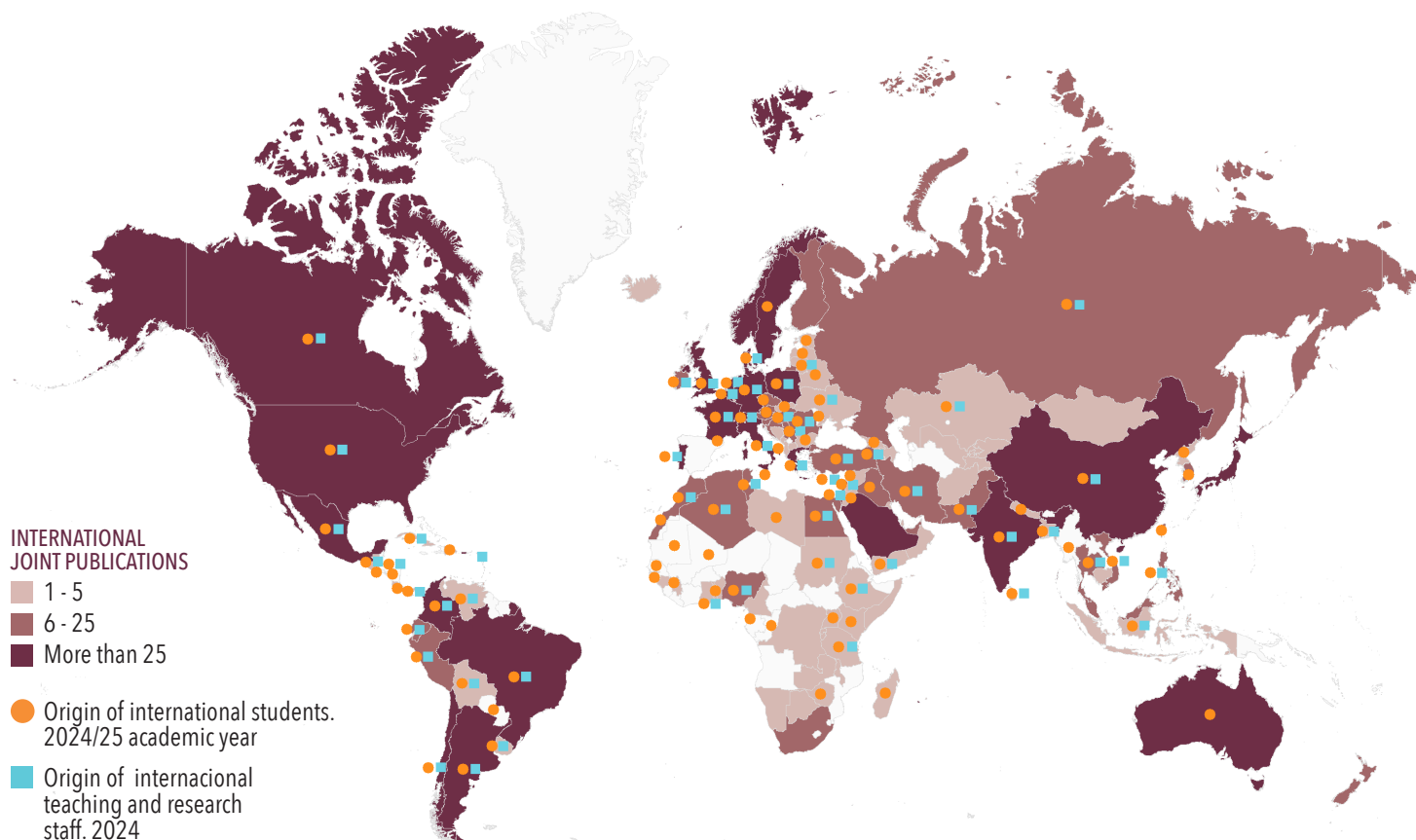
