


## 7. Admitted pending accreditation of qualification with bridging courses

## Dear [Nom del candidat/a],

We are pleased to inform you that the Coordinator / Academic Committee of the Master's Degree in **[Nom del màster]** has evaluated your application and documentation and has decided to admit you to the master's degree on academic grounds, even though you have not yet presented either 1) the certificate for qualification that gives you access to the master's degree or 2) the document proving that you have paid for the issuance of this certificate.

This means that you have a place on the course for the **[Curs Acadèmic]** academic year; however, you will not be able to complete the registration process until you present one of these documents.

As soon as you have one of these documents, you must upload it to the document manager. The document manager will tell you the deadline for uploading, modifying or consulting your documentation.



You can also check whether your documents comply with the <u>formal requirements</u> and monitor their status.

When you have uploaded the required documentation with formal requirements, we will give you access the registration process and you will be able to complete the registration process.

You can monitor the changes to your registration status via the <u>document manager</u>. We will also send you an email with all the information regarding the registration process.

On the basis of your previous qualifications, the Coordinator / Academic Committee has decided that you must study certain subjects as Bridging Courses, for which you must register. You can use the document manager to find out which subjects you need to study.

If you have documentary proof of any of the situations listed below, upload it to the corresponding section of the <u>document manager</u> so that the university can apply the exemption and you are not required to pay to reserve your place in advance:

- Disability of 33% or higher
- Victim of intimate-partner violence
- Victim of gender-based violence other than intimate-partner violence
- Large family (special category)
- Victim of a terrorist attack
- Beneficiary of the minimum living allowance

You can check other exemptions <u>here</u>.

Although, as we have indicated, as a general rule you cannot register for the Master's Degree until you have completed your Bachelor's Degree, an exception has recently been introduced for Bachelor's Degrees taken in Spain. Thus, if, after the September call for applications, you have a maximum of 9 credits with your Bachelor's Thesis still pending, you can apply to register provided there are places available and as long as you do so in line with the corresponding procedure.
